Solinftec moving its global headquarters to Indiana and raising an additional \$60 million in venture capital.



Inari expanding its footprint in Indiana as a result of its \$89 million venture capital investment announced in 2019.



Hello Nature's development of a \$6.8 million R&D center focused on the production of organic fertilizers, biostimulants and beneficial microbials that are safe for the environment and human health.



Mission Foods plans to establish a manufacturing plant in Indiana, creating 544 new jobs when it opens.



Greenleaf Foods plans to construct North America's largest plant-based protein manufacturing facility in Indiana, creating 460 jobs when it becomes operational.



Elanco plans to establish a new global headquarters on a 45-acre industrial site located in downtown Indianapolis, retaining 1,600 existing jobs in Indiana as well as 570+ jobs over the next 10 years.
