Corteva announces the relocation of their global headquarters to Indiana, making them the 4th largest company in the state by market cap.



IntelinAir moves its global headquarters to Indiana in addition to raising \$20 million in Series B funding.



True Essence Foods announces \$5.25 million Series A fundraise to expand its innovative offerings.



BiomEdit establishes its global headquarters in Indiana and raising \$40 million in Series A funding.



MPS Egg Farms announces a \$50 million investment alongside Hello Nature to create a specialty fertilizer facility.



Atarraya establishes its first U.S. sustainable shrimp farming operation in Indiana, investing \$4.8 million and creating up to 65 jobs by the end of 2025.



Inari expands its footprint in Indiana as a result of its \$89 million venture capital investment announced in 2019.



Hello Nature develops a \$6.8 million R&D center focused on producing organic fertilizers, biostimulants and beneficial microbials that are safe for the environment and human health.



Liberation Labs invests \$115 million to develop its first commercial-scale biomanufacturing facility, creating 45 new high-wage jobs.



DPH Biologicals opens its headquarters in Indiana in 2022 to deliver improvements to soil structure while increasing nutrient uptake across a wide range of crops and environments.



Elanco invests more than \$300 million in its Indiana operations including a new global headquarters as the epicenter of animal health, adding 570+ jobs over the next 10 years.



Taranis raises \$40 million in Series D funding and investing \$10.5 million to equip its new 6,000 square-foot facility in Westfield, adding 60 new, high wage jobs by the end of 2023.



Advanced Agrilytics establishes new 7,000 square-foot headquarters in downtown Indianapolis with plans to add another 60 new jobs over the next few years.
