

Food Is Health Co-Anchor

Emerging Food is Health Hub (available now); or One Health District (available late 2028)

- USDA locates **NASS** and **ARS** at a Purdue campus. Note that Purdue's Indianapolis locations are closer to this hub than West Lafayette.
- USDA locates **SNAP** and **Rural Development** at the former Elanco site as co-anchors of this Food is Health hub.

NODE 1 – West Lafayette + Downtown Indianapolis

NASS and ARS locate at a Purdue campus.

NODE 2 – Former Elanco Site · Food Is Health Hub

USDA locates FNCS, FSIS and Rural Development as co-anchors of Indiana's Food Is Health hub.

Emerging Food is Health Hub (former Elanco HQ)

Purpose-built redevelopment – scale, and infrastructure ready

USDA as co-anchor

USDA presence here defines the hub – grows in harmony with the rural landscape, establishes itself in an innovation ecosystem of farm to lab, on-the-ground commercialization effort

***Why this works for USDA:** No other state is building a Food Is Health ecosystem this intentionally. USDA co-anchoring this hub would not just serve the ecosystem, it would help define it. This scenario brings a narrative along with it.*
